NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

Pursuant to Chapter II, Article 7(a) and 11 of Law 2013-1996, as known as the "Telecommunications Act of Puerto Rico of 1996", as amended and in compliance with Law No. 38-2017, as known as the "Puerto Rico Government Uniform Administrative Procedure Act", as amended, the Telecommunications Regulatory Board of Puerto Rico, intends to approve:

CONSUMER CODE FOR WIRELESS TELEPHONE, MOBILE TELEPHONY, CABLE TV, IPTV AND SATELLITE COMPANIES


The purpose of the proposed regulation is to require to the companies that offer wireline telephony, mobile telephony, cable television, Internet platform video (IPTV) and satellite services, to provide Puerto Rico's residents informed options when selecting their provider of any of these services and ensure that they offer consumers an efficient and quality service.

The general public is hereby notified of their right to submit in writing, within thirty (30) days of this notice, their comments on the proposed regulation. Comments must be submitted in the Board offices by mail, personally and / or electronically to the email address secretaria@jrtp.gobierno.pr. The companies under the jurisdiction of the Board that submit comments, must also submit an electronic version using MS-Word on a CD or via e-mail.
